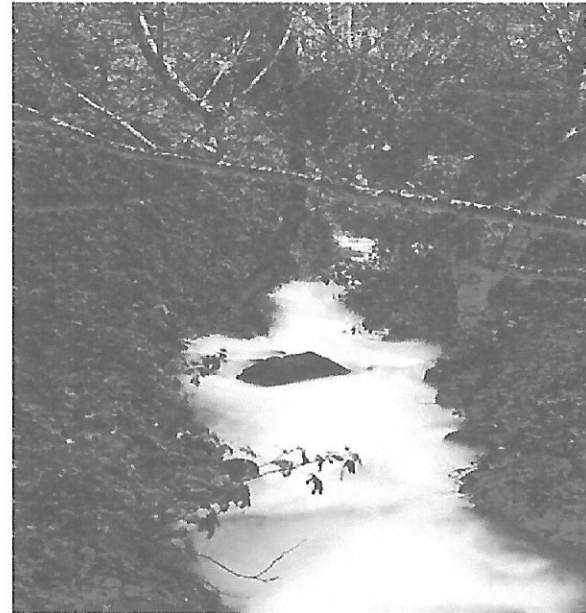


Tashlich-A Rosh Hashana Walk Thursday, September 21, 2017

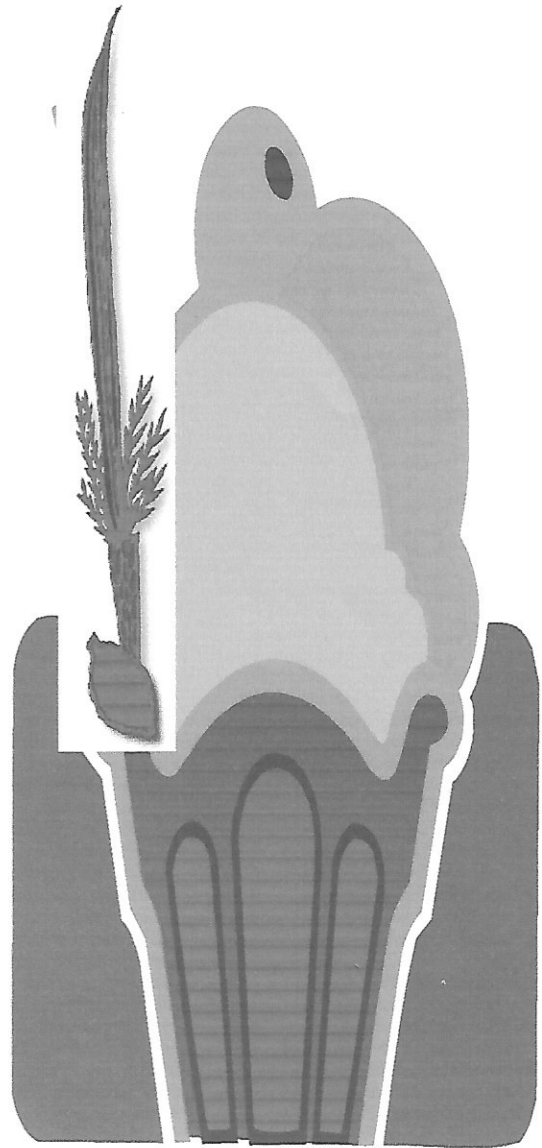
Tashlich is a beautiful ceremony where we gather around a body of flowing water and symbolically cast our sins away and renew, strengthen and heal our family for the New Year.



Join us for our annual Rosh Hashana walk to the new little park across the street from Waldbaums. Meet us at 5:00 P.M. in front of the Marathon Jewish Community Center or wait for us at the corner of 61st and Douglaston Parkway or greet us there at 5:15 P.M. for our Tashlich services. Immediately afterwards join us for a special healing service praying for a renewal of body and of soul for us and our loved ones. Obviously the Douglaston Plaza's parking lot will be open. Wear comfortable walking shoes and clothes.

How do you make A Lulav Shake?

Since time immemorial, blessing the **lulav** and **etrog** has been the Jewish way of thanking God for the blessings of the earth on the holiday of Sukkot. By holding the 4 species together, we symbolically "**get our own act together**" in preparation for the New Year. By pointing them in 6 directions, we remind ourselves that God's presence can be found in every area of our lives. By shaking the lulav and etrog vigorously, we commit to being movers and shakers in the world this year, for good and for blessing.
